

ACCREDITATION AND LICENSURE

HCA is licensed by the Russian Ministry of Education as an educational institution.





CURRICULUM

The high school provides students with a comprehensive college preparatory curriculum. This includes AP and honors courses that are available to juniors and seniors. Our academic program is American styled and internationally focused. Students that complete the necessary graduation requirements receive a high school diploma. Core classes meet 4 or 5 times per week for 45 minutes. Physical Education, Health, and other elective classes, including senior seminar, meet twice per week for 45 minutes. Extracurricular activities include Student Council, National Beta Club, choir, theater, and sports. Competitive sports teams include men's and women's volleyball, basketball, soccer, badminton and chess.

TESTING

All students grades K through 12th are tested annually with NWEA's MAP Growth Suite of Assessments. Currently, PSAT/MNSQT/AP testing is not offered in Russia.

The Russian/Ukrainian Conflict

As a result of the escalation between Russia and Ukraine that occurred February 24, 2022, Hinkson Christian Academy had to make several significant adjustments. Due to sanctions, HCA students can no longer take the PSAT, SAT, and ACT at the school or in the country. Students must leave to take these tests. Because of time restraints and issues getting in and out of the country students are often unable to take them for a second or third time. The conflict has changed our academic calendar. The 2022/2023 school calendar started late and will be ending late. Several key staff members were forced to leave the country and have not been able to return. Course offerings have been pared down and Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, and Calculus are instructed online. Mail service to the US and several other countries has also been discontinued. HCA is currently unable to mail transcripts or other documents unless there is a courier available.
